#### Solution

The logistics platform AX4 enables easy integration of suppliers and forwarders into Leoni Wiring System's supply processes. This enables worldwide sharing of the order and shipping data used to supply plants, storage sites, and distribution centers. From the pickup request to final delivery, Leoni maintains a centralized view of all the elements that make a supply chain successful: on-time performance, real-time location of goods, and reliable delivery fulfillment.

In addition, Leoni takes advantage of the option to store key files such as freight and customs documents electronically on the IT platform and share them with specific partners. Centralized access to data and documents relating to a transaction eliminates the need for repeated manual input of the same data by multiple partners, which simplifies operations and reduces the sources of errors.

#### Success

Using AX4, Leoni was able to cover all steps in the process, from the initial shipping request to the final delivery. The Leoni network mapped in AX4 already comprises more than 2,000 supplier locations, 64 plants, 63 logistics service providers, and 7 consolidation centers.

AX4 not only helps Leoni meet the strict logistics requirements of the automotive industry, it also helps achieve the sustainability goals of the industry customers: The IT platform yields end-to-end visibility of every movement of goods. This makes it possible to identify and seize consolidation opportunities early on and eliminate special transports.
